JUDGING

Judging will be conducted by a local panel of experts on Sunday, May 17, 2009.

Photographs of selected finalists will hang in the “Through the Eye of the Camera” exhibition which runs from May 20 through June 28, 2009.

The museum reserves the right to reject any work that it does not consider suitable or does not comply with the rules.

Any photography that is determined to have been digitally manipulated or enhanced in any way, and is not entered in the proper category, is subject to disqualification.

The decision of the judges is final.

If your work is NOT accepted for the show, you will be notified by Thursday, May 21 at 4 PM. PLEASE DO NOT CONTACT THE MUSEUM ABOUT THE STATUS OF YOUR ENTRY.

IMPORTANT NOTES

No photography is to be removed from the museum during the exhibition, except when purchased by out-of-town visitors.

The A.E. Backus Museum welcomes exhibition pieces and to the best of our ability will protect them from harm, but it will, in no way, be responsible for entries.

Work must be picked up at the close of the exhibition on either Saturday, June 27 or Sunday, June 28 between 1 and 3 PM . **No early pick up - No exceptions.**

The museum will close for the season on June 28. If work is not picked up before the close of the show you will need to call the museum to schedule pick up.

Any work left in the museum after July 1 belongs to the museum.
